



AirTrain JFK connects the airport to the following MTA Long Island Rail Road (LIRR) trains, MTA New York City Transit subways, and local buses at the Howard Beach and Jamaica train stations:

LIRR at Jamaica Station

E J Z subways at Sutphin Blvd/Archer Av/JFK Airport

A subway at Howard Beach/JFK Airport

NYC Transit Bus Lines Q6, Q8, Q9, Q20, Q24, Q30, Q40, Q41, Q43, Q44, Q54, and Q60 at Jamaica Station

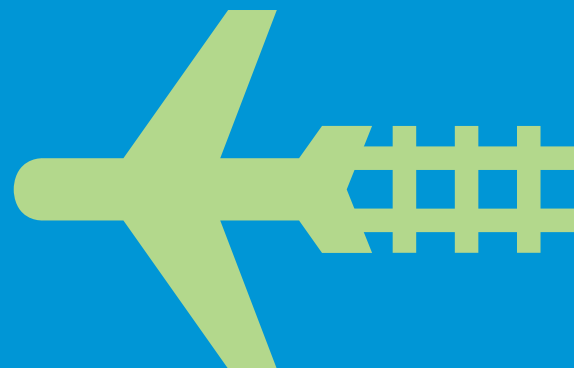

AirTrain JFK



The Fast, Convenient Airport Connection.

AirTrain JFK, brought to you by The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, is the better way to travel to, from and around John F. Kennedy International Airport.

Easy and convenient, AirTrain operates 24 hours a day and takes you from the AirTrain Jamaica or Howard Beach stations to your airline terminal in just minutes.

Connecting to or from JFK with AirTrain costs \$5.00* each way (children under 5 ride free). Payment is made at Howard Beach or Jamaica Station using a Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard®. 10-Trip AirTrain MetroCards are available for just \$25.00 and 30-Day AirTrain MetroCards are just \$40.00.

MetroCard Vending Machines accept cash (U.S. currency only), credit cards and debit cards. Machines dispense a maximum of \$6 in change (coins). Credit and debit cards are not accepted at subway station booths.

Inside the AirTrain station at Jamaica, you can purchase a LIRR ticket with a \$5 MetroCard on the back. LIRR ticket machines return a maximum of \$17.75 in change (coins).

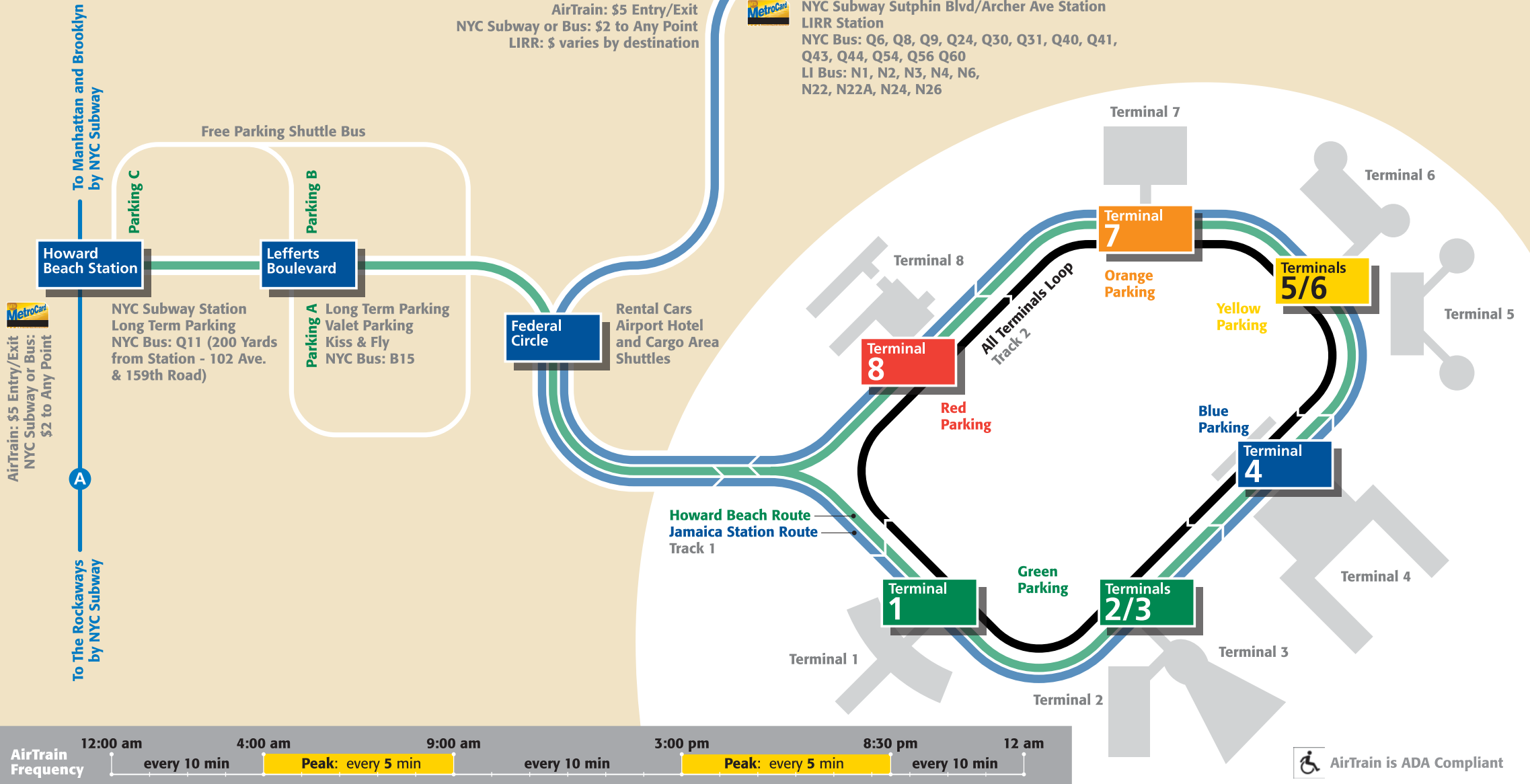

NYC Transit Subway Service to Jamaica or Howard Beach Stations

The NYC Transit subway is a service of the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) and operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
